

GOODWOOD BIBLE BOWL 2009 RULES

QUESTIONS

- All questions and answers were taken from the New King James version.
- Any question may be re-worded if needed to fit on the powerpoint slide, to provide more context, or to correct minor errors.

DIVISIONS

- Division 1: Completed grades 1 and 2 (or younger)
- Division 2: Completed grades 3, 4, 5 (or younger)
- Division 3: Completed grades 6, 7, 8 (or younger)
- Division 4: Completed grades 9, 10, 11, 12 (or younger)

Please note: A child can “play up” to any division. However, an older student cannot play in a younger division. Also note that the divisions are based on the grade last completed.

HOW THE COMPETITION WORKS

- There will be 10 questions per round. (These will be chosen from the book, but in random order.)
- Four members from each team will play per round. If a team has more than four players, only four can play in a round and there can be no substitutions during the round.
- Each question with choices will be read twice, and will be displayed on the screen(s) for the team to view.
- After the question is read for the second time, the participants will have 5 seconds to think about the answer. After that time, the quizmaster will say, “SHOW YOUR ANSWER.” Every team member for that round will show their answer. No changes in an answer are allowed.
- After the scorekeepers have recorded the answers, the quizmaster will say, “PUT DOWN YOUR ANSWERS.” It is important to teach your teams to follow these instructions. If the answer is put down prior to being instructed, it is at the quizmaster’s discretion to accept/not accept the response.
- Each correct response scores 10 points. If all 4 members of a team answer correctly, there is a 10 point bonus.
- If a team has a perfect score of 500 in a game they will be awarded a 10 point bonus.
- Each team’s lowest 2 scores will be thrown out.
- All other points scored will be accumulated throughout the competition.
- At the end of the day the total points will be compared against the other teams in each division for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place.
- In the event of a virtual tie for placement, there will be a one game playoff. If there is a tie at the end of this 10 question playoff game, there will be a 5 question tie breaker. Tie-breaker questions will be taken from the question book for Divisions 1 and 2. For Divisions 3 and 4 tie breakers will deal with the context of the questions in the question book. This may include a new question, combination of several questions, or rewording of questions.
- Each team will play the same number of games depending on the number of teams in the division.
